One of our staff has started a ministry in Syria. He must work "under the radar" to avoid trouble with authorities. Another fellow and his wife are establishing a ministry to the Bedouins in Egypt. This is dangerous especially for her because she doesn't wear the headcovering that the Muslim women wear. Both of these ministries need a vehicle for personal safety. Pray for the finances needed to buy reliable cars.

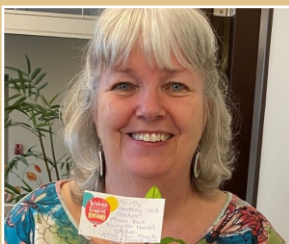

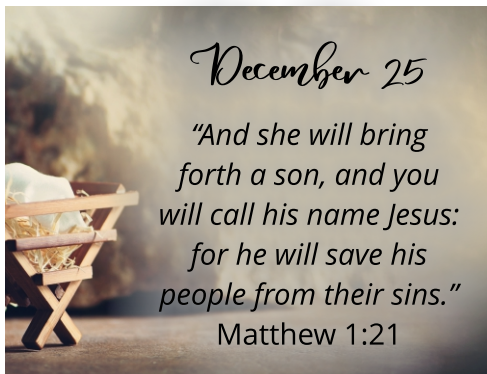
