# Kids Ministry FAQs

**Do all the people who serve as leaders in Kids Ministry have Criminal Record Checks?** Yes! All adults (age 18+) have up to date Criminal Record Checks as well as references done before serving.

#### What other safety protocols do you have in place?

Our kids' space is highly secure, with locking doors to all classrooms and hallways. Our check-in and check-out system also keeps children safe. Ask us more about how this works in person!

#### Can I go with my child into their classroom?

While we prefer to encourage kids to be independent and learn to trust our capable leaders, we know that sometimes kids need a little extra support getting started. Please check with our Welcome Team when you come to the kids' area on a Sunday to get checked in as an adult guest, which we can walk you through.

#### What do you offer for kids who may need extra support?

We are currently working towards increasing our ability to support kids with diverse needs. Our goal is to create a more inclusive environment for everyone by building new systems into our current structure and allowing more flexibility for those who need it.
